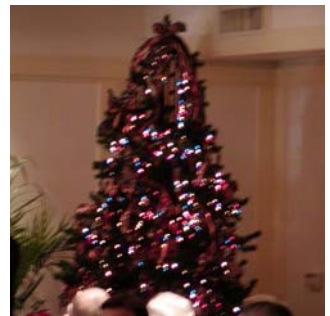


## **THE PREZ SAYS : HAPPY NEW YEAR!**
