3. **Printing**. We'll need envelopes, programs, and store window signs.

4. **Money**. Accounting for Concert receipts and expenses is traditionally the club treasure's responsibility but he will need some help. For example, where should the checks be sent and to what account; how to handle cash receipts the day of the Concert; who will authorize expenditures, etc.

I really need your help in planning some of these things. The concert WILL take place, the bands ARE committed, the format IS the same....the "usual suspects" WILL show up on Friday to set up, and on Saturday work at the concert....But please join me **THIS THURSDAY AT 5PM AT OAKWOOD ATHLETIC CLUB** to think through some of the details that need to be thought through and decided. I'm not asking you to "sign up" for the work...I just want your input and maybe a few guys (and gals) to help me in the next few weeks. This is Rotary's main fund raiser. We've been doing it for eleven years. The community enjoys it. It raises money for the schools and our Rotary projects. Our club gets lots of recognition. It's a lot of fun.....so, **PLEASE COME TO THE PLANNING MEETING THIS THURSDAY AT 5PM AT OAKWOOD ATHLETIC CLUB.**
