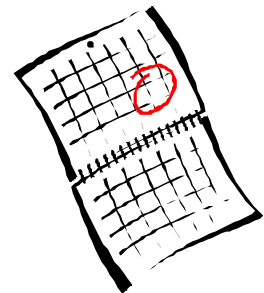
Next week, Midge Shusta will share with us a research project that resulted in a very wonderful book.
