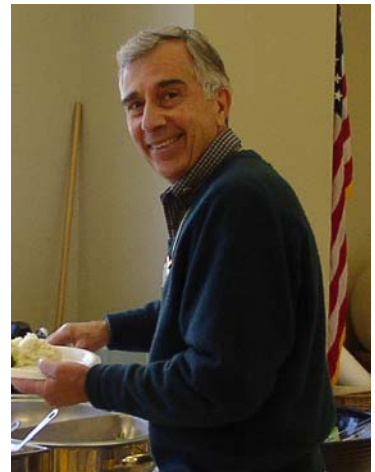


THE PREZ SAYS : TODAY IS A
