the new Librarian, a San Ramon resident, grew up in San Francisco. She took her librarian training in the Boston area, before working at MIT and Yale. After eight years in academic libraryship, she got back to public librarianship, and then returned to the west coast with her husband, two teenagers and eight cats. Anna told the Rotary of the many programs run through the library: kids' programs, non-traditional programs, like books on tape and CD, DVDs, and so on. The library averages 500 patrons per day. Unfortunately, with only 6000 square feet of space, every added resource takes away from other programs. Hopefully this will improve when the new library, at approximately 24,000 square feet, opens. It is contemplated that the new library, in addition to being much larger, will have a new kids' section, a teen section, the historical society, and a large meeting hall, among other resources, including underground parking for some 80 - 90 cars. The number of hours of operation will increase from 40 to 60 hours per week.
