## **PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE: THIS WEEKS**

message is an update on Charlie Vitale's wife Shirley; who is also Doug Johnson's mother-in-law. Yesterday at approximately 9:30 a.m. Shirley was taken in to surgery to have a pace maker implanted for her heart. Shirley had a team of 3 doctors as well as 18 nurses to coordinate the 3 hour procedure. Shirley's procedure was more complicated than the normal pace maker implant because with a standard pace maker implant 2 wires are inserted to 1 side of the heart. However, in Shirley's procedure a third wire needed to be inserted completely through the heart past both heart valves to the opposite side of the heart and the other 2 wires. This third wire had to pass through the heart while it was beating and there was a possibility that the doctors may not have been able to implant the third wire at all. Fortunately all the wires were implanted to there proper positions and the pace maker is functioning well. The pace maker implanted is actually in constant contact with a computer at the hospital and Shirley's heart is being electronically monitored and regulated 24 hours a day 7 days a week 365 days a year by the device! Shirley is doing well and should be home later today.

Our Club has been asked to hold the celebration of the delivery of the fire truck to the Village of Guadalupe, Mexico on September 10<sup>th</sup>. There will be a dinner at a winery, located in the Village of Guadalupe which will include Rotarians not only from Mexico but also the United States. The event will be attended by RI President Elect 2005-2006, Carl-Wilhelm Stenhammar. This visit is organized by the District Governor for District 4100 which covers Baja, Mexico. The event includes a visit to the Village of Guadalupe facility being completed with the assistance of the Rotary Club of Ensenada to house the fire truck and an ambulance. Bob Shusta has reserved six tickets, which are limited, for the event at \$35 each which includes dinner. Hotel reservations in Ensenada must be made soon. Three hotels are recommended with a cost range from \$58 to \$130 per night U.S. Bob has this information and will coordinate the reservations. The plan is to fly to San Diego on a Southwest Air flight on Thursday, September 9<sup>th</sup>, rent a vehicle and drive to Ensenada in time to attend their Club meeting which is at 8:30pm.
