Sow the Seeds of Love.

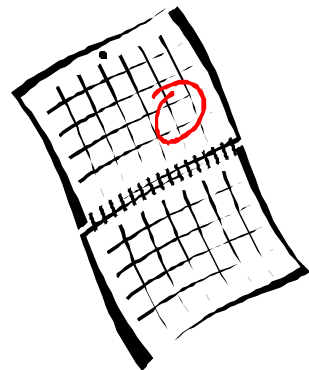
