PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE: THE SPEAKER

on October 14 was Rick Cronk (previously president & CEO, Dryers Ice Cream). Since Rick retired from Dryer's Ice Cream, and for many years previous to his retirement, he has been very involved with the Boy Scout movement. Rick described how in Boy Scouts there is approximately one adult volunteer for every three Scouts, and that holds not only all across the United States but also in the local council here in Contra Costa and Napa Counties. He also reported that 45% of all students in the primary grades are of Hispanic origin, 39% are Caucasian, 8% African-American and 8% of Asian descent. For this reason Boy Scouts has the policy totally throughout the Scout movement that anything printed in English is also printed in Hispanic languages. Rick reported the requirements for becoming and Eagle Scout and how
